Concrete, concrete blocks, pumice blocks, drywall panels.

Application Method

- Remove dust, salts, oil, and any other substances that may compromise adhesion.
- Adhere the tape using adhesive from the "AD" line, according to the type of tile to be installed.
- In overlapping areas between tapes or between tapes and corner sheets, apply Termokir SE 980 (Elastosil).

General instructions

- Store the product in a shaded, well-ventilated area.
- The material is suitable for use up to 24 months from the production date, provided it is stored in its original packaging under recommended conditions.
- Permitted application temperature range: 5°C - 35°C.
- Protect the material from UV radiation for several weeks after installation.
- All work must be carried out in accordance with applicable standards.
- Before starting work, the company's representative must be summoned for on-site guidance.
